



X ORDIZIA MEETING

International Meeting Jose Antonio Peña

- RULES -

1. The X Ordizia Meeting – International Meeting Jose Antonio PeñaIt will be held on **July 4, 2026** at the Altamira stadium in Ordizia, organized by the club **Txindoki Group Jaso Athletics Team**.
2. The meeting will belong to the category **BRONZE** of the **World Athletics Continental Tour**.
3. All tests will follow the regulations of the **RFEA** and of **World Athletics**.
4. Spectators can choose from four different seating areas in the stadium: the main stand (€10), the additional stand (€10), the standing area behind the stands (€8), and the standing area around the court (€5). All ticket holders will be entered into a prize draw.
5. Registration:
 - **Athletes with RFEA license:** Registrations will be done through the “**CALL ROOM**” of the RFEA. The CALL ROOM will close on June 26 at 23:59.
 - **Athletes without RFEA registration (foreigners):** Registration will be done by writing to the email address ordiziammeeting@gmail.com.

The **lists of admitted students** will be published **June 28** on the Ordizia Meeting website and social media.

The **entry lists** (heats) will be published on **July 3** on the event's website and social media.

The registration **does not guarantee participation**. Participation will be by invitation only, after the list of registered participants is compiled.

If an admitted athlete does not intend to participate, they must notify the organizers. Failure to do so will result in their ineligibility to participate in the Meeting for **two years**.

6. Eventz:

- **Women:** 100 m, 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m, 100 m hurdles, long jump and shot put.
- **Men:** 100 m, 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m, 110 m hurdles and long jump.

7. The men's shot put will also be contested. I will be **Category F**.

8. **Number** of participating athletes per event and series.

* One of the series of these tests will be composed exclusively of local athletes (from the seven provinces of Euskal Herria).

9. The long jump event **will be mixed**. Six men and six women will compete, alternating their jump attempts. Each will have six jumps.

10. When performing the series, **2025 and 2026** marks will be taken into account. The best athletes will be included in heat A and the remaining ones in heats B, C... in a staggered manner.

11. **Children's events:**

- Under-10: 50 m
- Under-12: 60 m and 500 m



12. There will be one **para 100 m and 800 m** races for athletes with disabilities.

14. **Prizes*:**

*The corresponding taxes must be deducted from these prizes.

- The best performance, both for men and women, throughout the meeting (according to World Athletics scoring tables), will receive a trophy and a basque beret.
- The **top athletes from Guipúzcoa** (registered in Guipúzcoa; according to WA tables), both male and female, will receive a Mahala basket.
- **Guipúzcoa** record: €500
- **Basque Country** record: €750
- **Spanish** Record: €2000
- **European** record: €3000
- **World** record: Audi Q2 car

These prizes will only be awarded to event winners and **will not be cumulative**. Only the prize corresponding to the **highest-level** record will be awarded.

15. In the 100 m and 110 m hurdles races, only the **times obtained in the finals** will be considered when determining the top three positions.
16. The 100 metres will feature an **A Final and a B Final**. The results of both finals will be taken into account to determine the final standings.



17. In the 400 m, 800 m, and 1500 m events, **performances from any heat** will be considered when determining the top three positions.
18. **Paces** will be provided for all international 800 m and 1500 m races to set the pace. The times of these paces are yet to be determined.
19. The organization and measurement of all events will be managed by **judges from the Guipuzcoa Athletic Federation**.
20. Athletes selected by the Basque Anti-Doping Agency's doctors will undergo **doping controls**.
21. If athletes who have passed doping controls are eligible for any prize, these prizes will not be distributed until the doping test results are published. **In case of positive results, these prizes will not be awarded.**
22. All results will be published on the meeting's website, the Guipuzcoa Athletic Federation's website, and the RFEA's website.
